**AMERICAN FREEDOM ALLIANCE TO HONOR DUTCH PARLIAMENTARIAN  
GEERT WILDERS AND BRITISH ACTIVIST ALAN CRAIG , SUNDAY, JUNE 7, 2009  
AT THE REAGAN LIBRARY IN SIMI VALLEY**

**Los Angeles, CA:** The American Freedom Alliance, a think tank and activist network based in Los Angeles will honor controversial Dutch parliamentarian Geert Wilders and British councilman and activist Alan Craig as its 2009 Heroes of Conscience Dinner at the Ronald Reagan Presidential Library in Simi Valley. It will take place Sunday, June 7, 2009 at 7:00 pm. Ticket prices are \$350 and the event is open to the public.

Geert Wilders, born a Roman Catholic, has achieved much attention in Europe for his outspoken views on the threats posed to the West by the rise of radical Islam and a fervent proponent of Western ideals and values. Wilders is the leader of Holland's Party for Freedom. Polls indicate, that if an election was to be held today, Wilders' party would win a plurality of votes and he would be elected the next Dutch prime minister.

Alan Craig is the leader of the Christian People's Party in London and for four years has led a vigorous campaign against the construction of the London "mega- mosque" slated to be accommodate 70,000 people, close by the Olympic Village of the London 2012 Olympics. The proposed mosque is sponsored by the secretive, fundamentalist Islamic sect Tablighi Jamaat which has a history of financing terrorism and producing extremist adherents.
